**WALKING/CYCLE ROUTE FROM KNOCKSEDAN TO SWORDS MANOR –

**Question: Councillor D. Mulligan**

“To ask the Chief Executive if she could examine the feasibility of creating a walking/cycling route from Knocksedan to Swords Manor?”

**Reply:**

In the Swords manor area, the Active Travel section is developing detailed design proposals for the inclusion of protected cycle paths and upgrade of existing footpaths along St Cronan’s Avenue, and Brackenstown Road from the roundabout at its junction with Abbeyvale Avenue and Parkview to St Cronan’s Senior School. These works are being fully scoped out at present and will be presented to the members in due course.

Proposals for a connection between Knocksedan and Swords Manor can be included in our connectivity tracker, from which it will be assessed for feasibility and implementation.
