**Maintenance of Environs in Council Managed Estates - AI098727**

**Question: Councillor D. Mulligan**

“To ask the Chief Executive to advise why the environs of Council managed estates, such as those in Rolestown Square, are allowed to fall into near disrepair while awaiting the process of being Taken in Charge, and to explain why they are not being maintained by the Operations Department during this time?”

**Reply:**

The environs of Council managed estates are normally taken into maintenance by the Operations Department once all services have been certified for handover from the developer, these services which would include roads, footpaths, surface water, open space and landscape maintenance, public lighting etc.

Due to the delay however in the current process for handover of estates to Operations, it has been agreed that the Operations Department will liaise with the Housing Department regarding interim measures to address current issues.
